Welcome to the CBIST training webinar!

Your CBIST training will be 1.5 hours. The training will be in two parts:

Part 1 (30 minutes)

This part will deal with general and administrative information you need to know as a CBIST and will include information on the ACBIS Advisory Board, ACBIS programs and services, CBIS and CBIST certifications, the certification process, roles/responsibilities/expectations of CBISTs, renewals, continuing education requirements and more.

Part 2 (60 minutes)

This part will be a “train the trainer” session to enable you to teach a preparation course using the comprehensive CBIST preparation curriculum materials for instructors and participants.
